Note: Appointment of Proxy

A proxy shall be appointed in writing in the common or usual form. You may give your proxy general authority to vote on your behalf or direct how you wish your proxy to vote on any item of special business. The document appointing a proxy and any power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which the proxy is signed (or a copy of that power or authority certified to be a true copy by a legal practitioner or justice of the peace) must be given (and may be given by facsimile) to the Secretary at the registered office of the Society, Law Society Building (3rd Floor), 170 Phillip Street, Sydney (or by facsimile to (02) 9926 0166), not less than forty-eight (48) hours before the time for holding the meeting or adjourned meeting at which the person named in the document proposes to vote, and in default the instrument of proxy shall not be treated as valid.
