

Mock Trial Competition – Conditions of Entry

1. The Competition is open to students in years **10** and **11 up to the age of 21**. Each School may enter one team only, which consists of 6 students.
2. The Law Society reserves the right to reject any entry or if a matching team cannot be found.
3. Schools will bear all costs of participating in the Competition, including travel and accommodation expenses.
4. Trials between schools will be held half-way if there is distance involved. However in the later Elimination Rounds, all trials will be held half-way and Schools must be prepared to travel.
5. If a School is unable to comply with any of the conditions and wishes to withdraw from the Competition, it must do so within a week of registering to receive a full refund.
6. The Competition material is password protected and all Mock Trial material will be accessed from the website. School must provide an email address to receive this information. If the school has not provided an email address, then the Law Society will not be responsible for that school missing out on updates and changes to scripts etc.
7. Each round must be completed by the date nominated by the Law Society and the results forwarded to the Society on or before that date. Any team which does not complete a round by the due date will be disqualified.
8. The Magistrate's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. The Law Society reserves the right to alter the roster or competition timetable at any time. Notification will be sent to all Schools via email.
10. Lap top computers are not to be used in the Competition.
11. Any disputes which cannot be resolved will be determined by the Co-ordinator, whose decision will be final.
