

# STEP UP TO **CET Up**

## What is CET Up?

**CET Up** is a peer support program run by and for members of the NSW Young Lawyers Communications, Entertainment and Technology Law Committee (CET). The 2010 program runs from August to December.

## How does CET Up work?

All members of CET are eligible to participate in **CET Up**. There were 10 Juniors and 10 Seniors in 2009. Undergraduate law students are **CET Up** Juniors. Lawyers and graduates are **CET Up** Seniors. Mature aged undergraduate students may be **CET Up** Juniors or **CET Up** Seniors. Allocations in 2010 depend on the number of participants.

Each Junior is “set up” with a Senior in the first month of **CET Up**. Each “set up” has contact, preferably face-to-face, between each monthly CET meeting.

The Junior and Senior should discuss how best to structure their **CET Up** meetings to suit both their schedules. Sharing a 20-minute coffee break once a month is a good example of how to organise **CET Up** times (and caffeinate at the same time).

## What to expect from CET Up

The Junior and Senior openly discuss what they expect from **CET Up** from the outset. The Senior generally acts as a sounding board and guide for the Junior on issues relating to study, employment, professional development, and transition from university to graduate employment in the legal industry.

Juniors and Seniors can also use their **CET Up** time to learn more from each other about CET-related subject matter and to contribute to ongoing CET activities such as Special Interest Group discussions.

All discussions between the Junior and Senior about their personal circumstances remain confidential unless they mutually agree otherwise.

## What CET Up is not...

**CET Up** is not a recruitment service, a Tarot reading service, a professional counselling service, a legal service, an essay writing service or a match making service.

At the end of the program, the formal peer support relationship ceases and contact outside regular CET activities is at the discretion of Juniors and Seniors.



**CET Up** is separate to the NSW Young Lawyers Mentoring Program and is not intended to replace other sources of information or advice.
