Notification of Closing Law Practice, Ceasing to Engage in Legal Practice or Ceasing to receive Trust Money

Legal Profession Uniform General Rules 2015 – Rule 51(1)

Rule 51(1) of the Legal Profession Uniform General Rules 2015 provides that a law practice must give written notice to the Law Society Council within 14 days of the law practice ceasing to hold trust money because it ceases to exist as a law practice, to engage in legal practice or to practise in such a way as to receive trust money. The written notice must provide such details of those facts as are applicable, the dates of their occurrence and particulars sufficient to identify the law practice's general trust accounts.

This form, duly completed, will be accepted as written notification to the Law Society Council of a law practice ceasing to hold trust money because it ceases to exist as a law practice, to engage in legal practice or to practise in such a way as to receive trust money.
