

SOLICITOR STAMPS UNDER THE LEGAL PROFESSION UNIFORM LAW (NSW)

Practitioners who choose to use a solicitor stamp are reminded that there is no specific provision in the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW) concerning solicitors' stamps.

It is however common practice that stamps include the following information:

The practitioner's name and address, followed by an appropriate title in accordance with Rule 9 of the Legal Profession Uniform General Rules 2015.
