

## **Notification of Opening a General Trust Account**

Legal Profession Uniform General Rules 2015 – Rule 50(1)

Rule 50(1) of the Legal Profession Uniform General Rules provides that within 14 days after establishing a general trust account, a law practice must give the Law Society Council written notice of the opening of a law practice trust account.

This form, duly completed, will be accepted as written notification to the Law Society Council of the opening of a law practice trust account.
