Tips and Advice

1. Parties are encouraged to use the Pro Forma FLSS Orders.
2. The Pro Forma Orders can be varied or amended by the parties.
3. For example, if the parties agree to a certain geographical location for the mediation to take place, the Pro Forma Orders may be amended to reflect this.
4. Another example might be that the matter be referred to an agreed mediator from the panellists published on this page. In circumstances where this is included, we ask that you also provide an alternative should this mediator be unavailable.
5. It is also acceptable for parties to arrive at an agreed list of mediators, of which they would like us to refer their matter out to. Parties may include a list of three (3) to five (5) mediators from the panel. We ask that parties refrain from listing mediators they do not want.
