Professor Colin Picker (*A.B. Bowdoin, JD Yale, PhD UNSW*) joined the University of Wollongong in 2017 as Dean of Law, to which he added the position Pro Vice-Chancellor (South Western Sydney) in July 2018. From 2010-2017 he was at UNSW Law where he was Director (and founder) of the *China International Business and Economic Law* research centre as well as Associate

Dean (International).

Prior to joining UNSW he was the Daniel L. Brenner/UMKC Scholar & Professor of Law at the University of Missouri - Kansas City School of Law.

He entered academia in 2000, after practicing in the DC law firm Wilmer, Cutler & Pickering. He was a founder and the first executive Vice-President of the *Society of International Economic Law*. He has published widely in the areas of International Business/Economic Law. Most recently his focus in publications and presentations has been on China's relationship to international economic law (trade, investment and finance), with many articles, book chapters and edited collection books.

His recent works include a Cambridge University Press edited collection entitled "China in the International Economic Order: New Directions and Changing Paradigms" (2015) and a Hart (Oxford) press edited collection entitled "The China Australia Free Trade Agreement: A 21st-Century Model" (2018).
