Dr Pamela Hanrahan is Professor of Commercial Law and Regulation at the UNSW Business School Sydney and a Senior Fellow of the Melbourne Law School. She has practised, taught and written in the areas of corporate law, securities law and financial services regulation for many years, and is a former Regional Commissioner of ASIC.

Pamela is a Fellow of the Financial Services Institute of Australasia, a member of the Executive of the Business Law Section of the Law Council of Australia, a member of the Corporate Governance Committee of the Australian Institute of Company Directors, and a non-executive director of Landcom. In 2016-17 she served on the expert group for The Treasury's ASIC Enforcement Review Taskforce and in 2018 she was an adviser to the Hayne Royal Commission into misconduct in the Australian financial services industry.
