PARTY A1: Vinny/Violet

You have always gotten on so well with Mike/Maisy and Luke/Lily and felt there was mutual respect between you're the four of you. The fact that Mike/Maisy is now standing up for people he/she doesn't even know that well is so ridiculous!

It took you several months to save up for the iPad, and you were so proud that you managed to achieve your goal, especially as you only work one day a week in the kitchen of a local café – it took a lot of hard work to finally buy the iPad.
