Professor Richard Susskind OBE is an independent author, speaker, and adviser to international professional firms and national governments. His main interest is in the impact of technology on professional services. He is the world's most cited author on the future of legal services. He is Chair of the Advisory Board of the Oxford Internet Institute, President of the Society for Computers and Law, and has been Technology Adviser to the Lord Chief Justice of England and Wales since 1998. In the 1980s, he wrote his doctorate on artificial intelligence and law at Balliol College, Oxford. His work has been translated into 15 languages and he has been invited to speak in over 60 countries. He has written ten books, including *The Future of the Professions* (2015, with D Susskind), *Tomorrow's Lawyers* (2nd edition, 2017) and *Online Courts and the Future of Justice* (2019).
