



Mock Mediation 2021 - Conditions of Entry

- 1. The Competition is open to students in years 9 and 10 up to the age of 21.
- 2. Each School may enter one team only, which consists of a core team of 6 students, and additional reserves.
- 3. Schools will bear all costs of participating in the Competition, including travel and accommodation expenses.
- 4. If a School is unable to comply with any of the conditions and wishes to withdraw from the Competition, it must do so within a week of registering to receive a full refund.
- 5. The Competition material is accessible from the website. Schools must provide an email address to receive this information. If the school has not provided an email address, then the Law Society will not be responsible for that school missing out on updates and changes to scripts etc.
- 6. Each round must be completed by the date nominated by the Law Society and the results forwarded to the Society on or before that date. Any team which does not complete a round by the due date, without prior permission from the Coordinator will be disqualified.
- 7. The Adjudicator's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 8. The Law Society reserves the right to alter the roster or competition timetable at any time. Notification will be sent to all Schools via email.
- 9. Laptops and phones are not to be used in the Competition.
- 10. Any disputes which cannot be resolved will be determined by the Mock Law Coordinator, whose decision will be final.
