Dr Cathy Sherry is a leading Australian expert on strata and community title. She provides advice to government and the private sector on the complexities of collectively-owned property, both nationally and internationally.

She was on the Technical Committee for the United Kingdom Law Commission reform of commonhold. Her book, Strata Title Property Rights: Private governance of multi-owned properties (Routledge 2017), the first academic legal monograph on strata title in Australia, has been cited by the Privy Council (O'Connor v

Proprietors, Strata Plan No.51 [2017] UKPC 45).

Cathy's research focuses on the social implications of private communities, as well as optimal planning for children.

Cathy has a special interest in urban farming and the challenges of providing growing space in high density cities.
