Dr Nicole Graham is Associate Dean (Education) at Sydney Law School. She teaches and researches in the fields of property law and theory, and legal geography. Nicole's research addresses the agency of law in landscape change through the exercise of property rights: e.g. to farm, irrigate, mine, and deforest. She has written on the relationship between property law, environment, and culture through the lens of the concept of place. With Professors Margaret Davies and Lee Godden, Nicole is undertaking an ARC Discovery Project entitled 'Property as Habitat: reintegrating place, people and law'. She is also working on an ARC Discovery Project with Associate Professor Robyn Bartel entitled 'Tenants of the Soil: adapting agricultural land ownership in Australia'. Nicole also researches the role of legal education in addressing climate change and has received teaching awards for her work teaching in the core curriculum of the LLB and JD programs.
