Jenny has been a legal practitioner for over 26 years with substantial expertise in competition and consumer law, litigation and issues facing government lawyers, including privacy and freedom of information, across government and corporate legal practice.

She is a Principal Lawyer in the Competition and Consumer Law Unit (CCLU) of the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC).

In this role, she provides legal advice, strategic direction and overall litigious case management on competition and consumer law matters and related issues.

In 2018-9 Jenny completed a 12 month secondment in the legal group of the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA). She assisted APRA with its work in response to the Royal Commission into Misconduct in the Banking, Superannuation and Financial Services Industry as well as other matters, including whistle-blower disclosures and possible contraventions of the Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993 (Cth).

Prior to her role in CCLU, Jenny was an Assistant Director in the ACCC's Enforcement Group, NSW. She has also practised in top tier law firms, namely the Competition & Trade group of Freshfields Bruckhaus Deringer in London, and the Litigation Group (specialising in competition and consumer law) of Allens (formerly Allen & Hemsley) in Sydney. Jenny has also been a longstanding member of the Law Society's Government Solicitors and Business Law Committees.
