Summary of changes

Reference	Change
Subclause 4(1)(b)(i)	Insertion of reference to 'the person' expressly covers circumstances in which a Minister has authorised a delegated person to make an order under subsection 11(2) of the Act.
Previous subclause 4(1)(b)(ii)	Deletion of the subclause.
Sch 1 – disclosure certificate	Replacement of reference to DPP being 'involved in the prosecution' with DPP 'exercises a function referred to in subsection (1A) of [section 15A of the DPP Act]' to clarify the circumstances in which the duty of disclosure applies and align language with the Act.
	Replacement of reference to 'Manager, Information Access and Subpoena Unit' with 'Office of the General Counsel' of the NSWPF to reflect current operational arrangements within the NSWPF.
	Insertion of reference to section 45A of the <i>Crime Commission Act 2012</i> , alongside the existing reference to section 45, as the Crime Commission can also make prohibitions or restrictions on publication under section 45A.
