Other roles:

Senior legal advisor to the Commander Australian Fleet, and as a Senior legal advisor at Headquarters (HQ) Joint Operations Command (HQJOC), in his HQJOC role Ian provided advice on combat operations in Iraq;

Command Legal Advisor to the Border Protection Command overseeing domestic maritime security operations. In this role Ian had a key role in the amendments to the PartIIIAAA provisions (DFACA) in the Defence Act in 2005;

Chief Legal Advisor to the Chief of Navy-Australia, in this role Ian coordinated the whole of Defence input to the drafting of the Maritime Powers Bill in 2012;

Military prosecutor and NSW police prosecutor.

Ian has deployed on border protection operations, East Timor, North Arabian Gulf and Afghanistan. Ian also served as the Commanding Officer of HMAS Penguin in Sydney.



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
